DAY	DESCRIPTION	MEALS
1 (SAT)	<p><b>Yangon arrival SQ5872 0920 - Lashio YH729 1130/1315 - Hsipaw</b></p> <p>On arrival Yangon International Airport, meet by your guide and transfer to domestic airport for flight to Lashio.</p> <p>Your Shan guide will pick you up from the airport for a 1.5 hour drive through Shan state towards Hsipaw. Arrive in this small town in Northern Shan state known for the beautiful scenery which happens to have one of the last remaining residences of a former Shan prince.</p> <p><b>Shan village walk</b></p> <p>In the late afternoon your guide will take you for a 2.5 hour walk through a panoramic scenery of paddy fields and other seasonal crops; passing small creeks, Shan villages, local schools and monasteries. The guide will explain in detail about Shan life around Hsipaw and show you some home industries like cheroot (cigar) rolling and bamboo weaving. He will explain why each Shan village has a spirit house build at the entrance of the village and make sure you will get to know the spirit of the local people in Northern Shan state.</p>	(NIL)
2 (SUN)	<p><b>Hsipaw - Kyaukme</b></p> <p>After breakfast, Going local today! The local bus to Kyaukme will depart opposite the beautiful colonial all-wooden post office which is a 3 min walk from your hotel. And when we say local we really mean local... the bus is stopping at every village to let people or goods in an out and basically functions a bit like the local postman (for letters, packages or big bags of rice). Expect to be surrounded (or sit on top of) vegetables, rice and anything else you can imagine, surrounded by local villagers.</p> <p>You will arrive at around 8:30 in Kyaukme. The market is the final bus stop. Here your local Khiri guide will be waiting for you to take you to the guesthouse where you will spend the night. Embark on a full day trekking through the mountains surrounding Kyaukme during which your guide will give you a fascinating insight into the life of the Palaung people living in these remote hills. We have lunch in one of the Palaung villages. Today is a great day out in the nature in an area where you can still find people who have rarely seen western foreigners before and who live according to centuries old traditions.</p>	(B,L,-)
3 (MON)	<p><b>Kyaukme - train over Gokteik Viaduct - Pyin Oo Lwin - Mandalay</b></p> <p>After breakfast you have some free time to explore the town with its colonial buildings and the busy and colourful market. Here you can buy some snacks and drinks for the upcoming train journey. The railway station is only a 10 minute walk from your hotel. You can also take a motorbike taxi with trailer for a small fee. We have reserved seats for you until Pyin Oo Lwin. Enjoy a wonderful train journey through the Shan mountains during which you will cross the mighty Gokteik Viaduct which was constructed in 1901 by the Pennsylvania Steel company and was once the second highest railway bridge in the world.</p> <p>The train departs at 11:05 from Kyaukme station and will pass the Gokteik Viaduct at around 1:30 PM. Through spectacular mountain scenery the train will slowly move forward over the old railway track passing small villages and towns where vendors will enter the train to sell drinks and local snacks. Expected arrival time in Naung Cho is around 14:00 and we then continue by private car to Mandalay but be warned: delays on an historic railway like this one are not unusual. Simple lunch boxes are provided on the way in the train.</p>	(B,L,-)
4 (TUE)	<p><b>Mandalay - Bagan K7 244 0840/0910</b></p> <p>Breakfast in the hotel. You will be met by your driver and guide for your transfer to the airport for your flight to Bagan. On arrival, you will be met by your driver and guide for your <b>full day orientation tour:</b></p> <p>A full day tour by car, with an experienced guide through Bagan will show you the best known temples of the area. We start the day climbing a pagoda to get a first impressive view over the whole area. From here the guide plans his way to some of the other amazing temples that have been here for hundreds of years. Places like the Ananda, Dhammayangyi, Sulamani, and Thatbyinnyu will certainly impress you. Lunch will be taken at a local restaurant and around 4pm we continue the tour by horse cart to sunset points for sunset with some refreshing drinks served.</p>	(B,L,-)

DAY	DESCRIPTION	MEALS
5 (WED)	<p><b>Bagan</b></p> <p>After breakfast in the hotel, visit Markets, monasteries and a boat ride to a 12th century hidden cave temple for a full day.</p> <p>An ideal excursion on your second day in Bagan when you feel like you have seen most of the temples (or at least enough) and also want to discover a bit more of the Myanmar country side. We go by private car to Kyauk Gu Ohnmin cave temple that rarely sees foreign visitors, continue to Pakkoku and visit a local slipper factory, the market and see where the famous Pakkoku blankets are made. A private boat is ready for you at the jetty in Pakkoku for a leisurely 2 hour trip downriver while lunch is being served on board. In the afternoon your guide and driver will show local village life in the dry zone and we will visit later in the day a lacquer ware workshop in Myinkaba village.</p>	(B,L,-)
6 (THU)	<p><b>Bagan – Heho K7 244 0925/1005 – Inle Lake</b></p> <p>After breakfast in hotel, You will be met by your driver and guide for your transfer to airport for your flight to Heho. On arrival, you will be met by your driver and transfer to Inle Lake.</p> <p><b>A day on the lake!</b></p> <p>Inle Lake in southern Shan State is a vast natural lake surrounded by traditional Shan villages. On the lake itself the Intha people have been living for many centuries in village built entirely on stilts on the lake. Today we will take you by private motorboat around the lake to discover the natural beauty of the lake, visit the floating gardens, see some of the famous leg rowers and have some tea at a local family's house. On and around the lake traditional markets are held in different villages according to a 5-day rotating schedule and today we will take you to visit a colourful market frequented by Shan and PaO people living nearby. We will certainly also visit a local house where cheroot (the Burmese cigars are made), floating tomato gardens, Phaung Daw Oo Pagoda, an Intha house where a traditional Intha lunch is served and if wanted we visit a weaving factory.</p>	(B,L,-)
7 (FRI)	<p><b>Inle Lake</b></p> <p>After breakfast in hotel, <b>Pa O for a day – full day trekking</b></p> <p>One of the distinctive hill tribes from Shan State are the Pa O who are known for their navy blue clothes and colourful red or orange turban and their good farming and trading skills. During this day trekking you get to know life as the Pa O live it and will visit their villages in the hills, eat their food and have the chance to dress like a Pa O (fun, at least for the picture!). We start with a 15 minutes horse cart ride from the hotel in Nyaung Shwe (or a boat ride from your hotel on the lake) and begin with a 2, 5 hours walk (a bit uphill) to arrive in a Pa O village where you have time to talk with the monks and where you will be invited to wear the traditional dress. Continue about 30 minutes (mainly flat) and arrive in a village where a traditional Pa O lunch is served with dishes like ginger soup, pumpkin leave salad and sukini leave salad. Time to relax and prepare for the afternoon walk which is about 2, 5 hour with stunning views on the lake and plantations with crops like ginger, garlic and turmeric. Just before boarding the boat to bring you back to the hotel we stop for a last beautiful view over the lake as a reward for having passed the Pa O experience.</p>	(B,L,-)
8 (SAT)	<p><b>Inle Lake – Heho – Yangon K7267 1105/1215</b></p> <p>After breakfast in hotel, You will be met by your driver and guide for your transfer to airport for your flight to Yangon. On arrival, you will be met by your driver and guide for your transfer to the hotel.</p> <p><b>Yangon Heritage walk – half day, afternoon</b></p> <p>Yangon downtown is unique with much of its colonial-era architecture still standing. You find one of Asia's most impressive collections of late nineteenth and early twentieth-century buildings, religious and secular. Starting after breakfast or lunch this walking tour will take you a step back in time, through downtown Yangon, focusing on its old colonial buildings, neglected or purposefully restored. Stop at the Secretariat, scene of the nation-stopping assassination of General Aung San which has been closed off to the public for over since the 1960s. After the tour you will have time to enjoy a drinks at Gekko, a cosy restaurant on Merchant Street in a historical building.</p>	(B,-,-)
9 (SUN)	<p><b>Yangon – Departure M1519 1735</b></p> <p>After breakfast in hotel, proceed to visit <b>Spiritual Shwedagon Pagoda - half day</b></p> <p>So what's behind the golden façade of the Shwedagon Pagoda? During this interactive half day tour we take you through the back door and show you the full history of the pagoda, the daily life of all people living in the immediate surroundings of the pagoda and a deeper insight in the Buddhist religion and how the spiritual belief is mixed with the belief in nats – the Myanmar spirits. An intriguing half day tour starting from the bottom of the hill and passing the workshops, markets and monasteries which will be useful or even essential to understand more of the country during the rest of your journey. The tour includes a traditional Burmese breakfast, offerings to monks and the pagoda, a visit to a fortune teller and a Burmese lunch.</p> <p>Have a free afternoon until transfer to the airport for your flight to home</p>	(B,L,-)
